Afternoon Tea at The Welly Community Café, 3.30pm till 5.30pm - £10.00 per ticket.



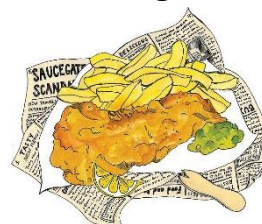
6th December - Residents Christmas Party at Abbeycliffe featuring Wayne Allen.

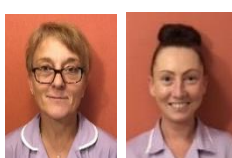
